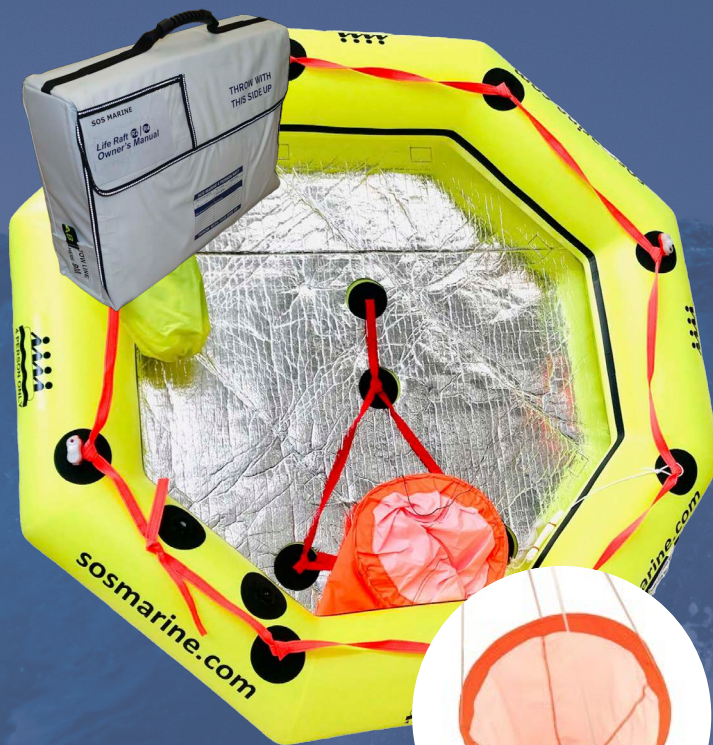

All seams and fitting points are
high-frequency welded and air tight
in accordance with ISO 12402



SOS RESCUE RING SOS-6409

- **Packed size:** 300mm X 120mm (12" x 5")
- **Weight:** Approximately 0.59kg (1.3 Pounds)
including cylinder
- **Co² Cylinder:** 33-gram disposable cylinder
operating mechanism
- **Bladder:** Neon yellow 210 denier nylon
single-side polyurethane coated with ultraviolet
resistance
- 70mm Red (2 ½") Oral Inflation valve
- 150 Newtons Inflation buoyancy
- SOLAS grade reflective tape is located on both
side of the buoyancy chamber
- The handle designed to assist in gaining further
distance throwing
- Reusable after recharge

OPTIONAL: It can be **vacuum
packed** for better storage protection
on jet skis and other potentially wet
boat areas. Prior to use the vacuum
bag has to be **torn-open** and thrown
under arm to the patient, an average
distance of 20m is usually achieved.

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
